



CAPE TOWN TO VICTORIA FALLS ZIMBABWE

01 October 2008—30 September 2009

A Leisurely Sojourn By Luxury Train via Zimbabwe

This relaxing six-day journey commences in Cape Town and ends at the majestic Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe. Between the two destinations is an adventure which includes 04 nights of luxurious accommodation on the train and one night's accommodation off the train in a deluxe Pretoria hotel, with transfers to and from Rovos Rail's private station in Capital Park. Off-train excursions during the journey include a stop in the quaint Victorian village of Matjiesfontein, a tour of the historical mining town of Kimberley and an overnight stay in a Pretoria hotel before journey's end at the Victoria Falls.

ITINERARY

Monday

11h00 Depart from Platform 23 at Cape Town Station and proceed inland to Worcester.

18h00 Upon arrival at Matjiesfontein guests may visit this quaint, historical village

19h00 Depart Matjiesfontein.

Tuesday

14h30 Upon arrival in Kimberley take the electric tram from the City centre for a tour of the Big Hole and museum.

Wednesday

12h00 Arrive at Rovos Rail's Capital Park Station, Pretoria.

Transfer to hotel for overnight. Tours of Pretoria and environs can be arranged on request.

Thursday

10h00 The Pride Of Africa departs from Rovos Rail's private station in Capital Park.

13h00 Lunch is served in the dining car en route to Zeerust.

19h30 After traversing the Magaliesberg Mountains dinner is served as the train heads towards Mafikeng for border formalities.

Friday

07h00 Breakfast served in the dining car until 10h00.

13h00 Lunch is served in the dining car.

19h30 Dinner is served in the dining car.

Saturday

07h00 Breakfast served in the dining car until 10h00.

13h00 Lunch is served in the dining car.

17h00

Arrive at the Victoria Falls where your Rovos Rail journey ends.

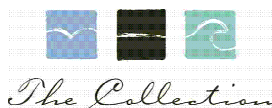

The rebuilt sleeper coaches contain the most spacious train suites in the world, offering every modern convenience and comfort. The epitome of luxury, with handsome wood panelling and period Edwardian features, the air-conditioned suites accommodate two people offering the option of twin or spacious double beds.

All are equipped with a writing surface and, for valuables, a personal safe.

There is also a bar fridge filled with beverages of the passengers' choice and room service is available 24 hours a day.

In the en suite bathrooms original fittings combine with the modern technology of hot showers, hair dryers and shaver plugs.



Cuisine & Service

Simple Elegant & Entertaining

An enthusiastic team of chefs is responsible for overseeing the very important task of ensuring guests every need is catered for, while considerable thought and meticulous planning goes into making up the menus.

There is an accent on fresh local ingredients, and traditional dishes such as game are a specialty.

Every morning there's a full breakfast with dishes cooked to order.

For lunch and dinner there is a starter and a choice of fish, meat or vegetarian dishes, followed by a tempting dessert and are complemented by a selection of excellent South African wines.

All meals are served in one sitting only in the charming Victorian atmosphere of the Dining Cars.

Many of the passengers aboard the Pride of Africa enjoy the formality of fine china, crisp linen and silver, and dress accordingly. During the day dress is more casual, with cool, comfortable clothes and hats recommended for the excursions, especially in the game reserves where it can be very hot.

The Observation Car seats 32 passengers and is positioned at the rear of the train.

At the centre of the train there is, when numbers dictate, a non-smoking Lounge Car, which seats 26 passengers in comfort.
